Title and abstract of the doctoral thesis (within 150 words)

The object of research is transitional words (a transitional word is any linguistic form that connects syntactic units in a complex sentence.)

The body of discourse markers is actively and continuously replenished with new units. The most promising way seemed to us the way of forming conscious transitional words on the basis of prepositions as a result of predicative nominalization (expansion of a simple sentence into a complex one).

In the dissertation, for the first time, a comprehensive description of the named group of service words is given and the Dictionary of Binders is presented, which, along with the already described in linguistics, includes a number of units not recorded in dictionaries, but actively functioning in speech.

In addition, the work compares syntactic constructions: simple sentences with a preposition and complex sentences with connectives formed on the basis of these prepositions, and also identifies the ways of their mutual transformation and the conditions that prevent this.

The research results can be used in university courses on syntax, in conducting special courses on syntactic semantics, as well as in teaching Russian as a foreign language, in lexicographic practice and in the preparation of textbooks on the Russian language.
