Specialization and domain of interest**Title and abstract of the doctoral thesis (within 150 words)****Economic Life in Egypt during the Ayybid Period (567-648HI 1171-1250A.D.**

This study begins with an introduction, in which the economic situation in Egypt in the last quarter of the Fatimid period and the beginning of the Ayubi in Egypt are studied. Then there are three chapters: The first chapter entitled Agriculture, in which the irrigation in Egypt which depends primarily on Nile River, its tributaries, gulfs and canals are studied. Then the irrigation methods as pools and machines as shadoof and waterwheels are studied. The agricultural crops were numerous, so there were nutritional crops, productive trees, fruit, fodder, and industrial crops. This chapter also studies the animal wealth. is also studied. Then this chapter studies Iqta which was correlated to military service and followed the Suljuqi line. The taxes and their collection dates, the economic crises, epidemics, diseases and their effect on economic situation are also studied in this chapter.

The second chapter studies trade. So the important trade centers in Egypt are studied. Ayubis secured the internal river and terrestrial commercial routes

from the dangers of robbers. Then the important eternal and weekly markets, and the supervision upon them are studied. Ayubis make obvious efforts to improve the external commercial relations, especially with Italian cities (Genoa, Pisa, and Venice), and allowed their traders to establish their especial hotels to facilitate their commercial treatments.

The third chapter studies industry and vocational regulations. So the important industries which were dominant in Ayybid period, as linen and wool textes, leather industry, nutritional industries as grain grinding, sugar industry and candy, and military industries which were important for Ayubis in Jihad with Crusades. The vocational regulations was based on vocational specialization, so there was a special market or district for each craft which was entitled by them. The vocational regulation was very precise, so there were in each craft arif, mualim, ustath, and mubtadi (sabi).
