Opening of SESAME on 16 May 2017

I am very pleased to invite you to the opening of SESAME (Synchrotron-light for Experimental Science and Applications in the Middle East) on its premises in Allan (Jordan), which will take place on 16 May under the patronage of His Majesty King Abdullah II.
